We at PGGC-11 offer umpteen opportunities to our young students to help them realize their potential and excel in varied fields. Social Societies

As part of the Chandigarh Administration's initiative the college has set up ten social outreach societies which sensitize and awaken young minds to be socially responsive citizens. These are AIDS Awareness Society, Best Out of Waste Society, Cancer Awareness Society, Community Hygiene and Sanitation Society, Drug De-Addiction Society, Environment Awareness Society, Gender Equity Society, Society for Preservation and Protection of Heritage, Sankalp Society and Road Safety and Traffic Awareness Society.

Redressal Cell for Physically Challenged Students

To hone up interactive skills of the differently abled students and help them build self-confidence, the cell is actively involved in organizing various interactive sessions from time to time.

Foreign Students' Council

Keeping in view the large number of Foreign students vying for admission to the college, a special Foreign Students' Council is set up to look after their interests and help and extend full support to them in case of any problem.

Personal Development Programme

Keeping in mind the fast changing job requirements, the Personal Development Programme which is a joint venture by Regional Institute of English, Sec. 32 and the UT Administration, polishes students' professional skills and renders them more employable. The core areas of the programme are interpersonal skills, communication skills and English Language proficiency.

Tutorial Groups

Giving due importance to the teacher-taught relationship, tutorial meetings are held regularly where students air and share their problems with their mentors freely. Through these meetings they are sensitized against social evils, smoking, ragging etc.

Career Counselling and Placement Cell

The CCPC of the college helps students to explore career options, prepares them for job interviews and also facilitates the campus recruitment process. The cell plans its activities through a feedback mechanism through its student campus coordinators.

UGC Scheme for Coaching of SC/ST and Minority Community Students for National Educational Testing

The PG departments of History, English and Punjabi have initiated NET coaching classes for SC/ST/OBC and Minority Community students under the UGC scheme.

NCC

The three wings of NCC for boys namely Naval, Army and Air Wing prepare cadets for 'B' and 'C' Certificate exams so that they may avail themselves of reserved seats in the I.M.A. meant for NCC 'C' certificate holders. As per NCC rules, a cadet is required to attend an annual training camp.

Sports

It being the only college in north India having four year integrated BPEd course and two year MPEd course, the department of Physical Education and Teacher Training admits some of the best sports persons from across the country in these courses who bring laurels to the college

in various games. The department has produced many national level sports persons and is relentlessly upgrading the sports infrastructure in the college. Hostel accommodation to a limited number of girl students is provided on institutional sharing basis in Government Home Science College Sector-10, Government Polytechnic College Girls Hostel, Sector-24. ON THE SPOT ADMISSION DOES NOT APPLY TO CANDIDATES WHO SEEK HOSTEL ADMISSION ALSO.

The Candidates have to apply in advance as per the instructions given below.

1. Candidates will submit duly filled in College Admission Form to the College Office on or before 30-06-2012.
2. Admission forms for the hostel applicants will not be accepted, if received later than 30-06-2012.
3. Incomplete forms will not be entertained.
4. The hostel seats are limited therefore admission to the college does not ensure the right of the candidates to the hostel seat.
5. Physical presence of the candidate is

Compulsory on the day of admission.

6. Parents to note that admission formalities / process may take more than one day. So they are required to make their own arrangements of stay accordingly.
7. In case the candidate does not pay his / her fee on the same day, his / her will lose the claim to the hostel seat.
8. The students seeking hostel admission are required to submit an affidavit from their parents authorizing the local guardians to perform all responsibilities after the admission on their behalf regarding hostel rules and regulations. They are required to bring a family photograph and also four passport size photographs at the time of admission.
9. Girl students recommended for the hostel accommodation will be governed by the hostel rules and hostel fee structure of the above mentioned respective college in which they are allotted hostel seats.
