Subject: Earmarking of site for the establishment of a new Government College of Commerce and Business Administration, Chandigarh.

His Excellency, the Administrator has recently accorded approval to a proposal to start a new Government College of Commerce and Business Administration from the academic session 2006-07 onwards, in overwhelming public interest.

A proposal for the setting up of a new college was mooted in the 10th Five Year Plan 2002-07 and was formally approved by the Administration. But this could not be implemented during these past four years despite the fact that there was a great demand for such a college. This would be a full-fledged College offering Commerce and Business Administration offering Graduation and Post-graduation courses. This will, for the time being, be a make-shift arrangement in the old DEO's office Building near the Main Market, Chandigarh subject to its shifting to an earmarked place in due course. In the interim, there shall be an additional demand for a full-fledged spacious college building and infrastructure during the next session for which necessary preparations are being made by the Punjab University, Chandigarh have already commenced.

It is therefore requested that suitable site for the establishment of a new Government College of Commerce and Business Administration in Chandigarh may kindly be made available for intimation to this office, in order to initiate urgent consequential action for the construction of the college building and making necessary budget estimates which are mandatory, in order to implement the decision in right earnest.
