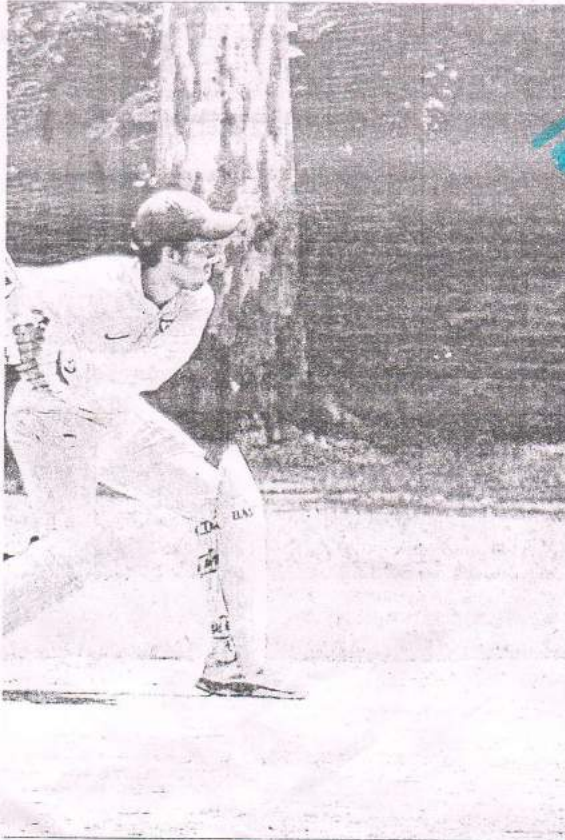


li, enter final Sandeep, Divleen cycle to claim top honours

CHANDIGARH: Sandeep Singh Sidhu and Divleen Kaur grabbed top positions in the men's and women's elite open category respectively in the Chandigarh State cycling championship near Kaimbala Village, Chandigarh, on Saturday and Sunday.

All the players who are participating in this tournament will be medically examined for age proof by our team of doctors and their decision will be final and binding on all the participants.

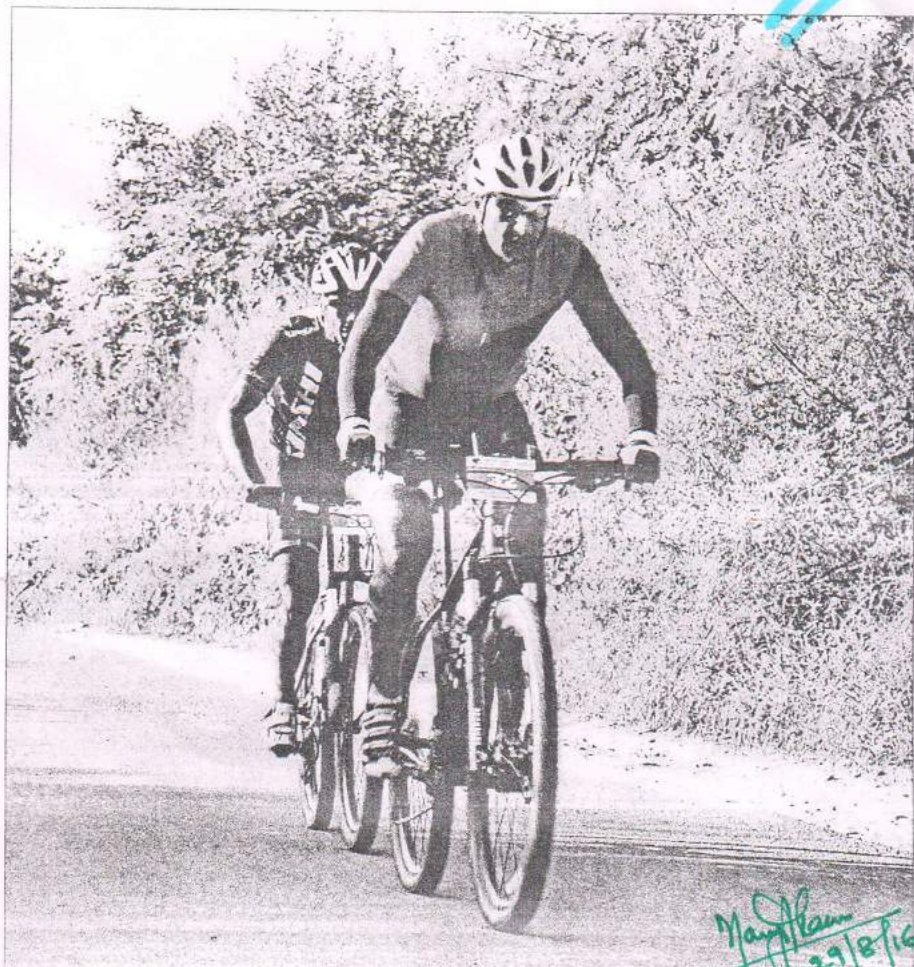
