It may also be ensured that the student is not availing any other scholarship and his/her Aadhaar no. is seeded with her/her bank account no. Aadhaar card and bank account with complete address and IFSC code of the account in the name of applicant is mandatory.

2. Aadhar Card is compulsory and Domicile is must for as a proof of Resident (Copy to be attached)
3. The students whose family income from all sources is not more than 2,50,000/- per annum for SC and 1,00,000/- for OBC are eligible. (Attach Affidavit in support)
4. Bank Account along with IFSC code (Copy of Passbook to be attached)
5. College Identification card and Fee Receipt (copy is to be attached).
6. Copy of Ration Card or any proof for permanent resident in Punjab.


**SCHOLARSHIP NOTICE**


**SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR STATE MERIT / RIOTS VICTIMS (NON PLAN)**


